Pre-school Buddies

All of the children who met their buddies last week were very comfortable and confident with them, which was lovely to see. Unfortunately, due to the weather this week, the children have been unable to experience the school playground with their buddies every break time. We will aim to get the children out with their buddies for as many break times as possible over the next few weeks.

Stepping up days

On Wednesday 14th, Thursday 15th and Friday 16th of June, all children who will attend Inch Primary School in August will have their stepping up days to Primary one. There will be no nursery sessions for these children over these three days.

The children who will be returning to us in August and the children who are starting primary one at another school will have nursery as normal and we will have visits from the new children who will be joining us at nursery in August.

Many of the children have requested that we visit the meadows more often and staff have observed lots of role play around the theme of picnics. Therefore, we aim to take each class across to the meadows play park for a picnic snack and a play before the end of term. This is likely to happen on either the week beginning the 19th of June or the week beginning the 26th of June. We have not set a date yet due to unpredictable weather and are likely to decide on the day that we will go. We will not need parent helpers for this, but ask that children come in suitable footwear for the meadows during the last two weeks of term.

On Tuesday the 27th of June we will have our annual Sports day/fun day at the Bennachie Leisure Centre. This will follow the same format as last year, which was very successful.

The morning session will be from 9am until 11.30am, with races for parents/carers to watch beginning at 10.45am
