#### **Reporting to Parents**

We are improving the way we report pupil progress to our parents. This is one of our main planned School Improvements for the coming year. Following consultation with our teachers and Parents Council, we have agreed a new reporting to parent's calendar. I have attached this for your information. The 'Learn' symbol shown here will be used to communicate when school is sharing learning with parents. The



aim of the initiative is to inform parents more regularly throughout the year of pupil progress. This is an Authority wide project. Schools and parents report greater satisfaction with the new arrangements.

## In short, what will it mean at Insch School?

- New Meet the Teacher event for each class 10<sup>th</sup> November at 5.30 6.15pm and repeated at 6.30pm 7.15pm. Not traditional parents evening.
- New Learning Stories A chance to see your child's individual learning each term. You can see this for the first time at the meet the Teacher event on 10<sup>th</sup> November. These will be shared each term with parents either in school or will be sent home.
- More traditional parents evening in Term 3.
- Reduced format written report with more meaningful learning comments in Term 4.
- Regular posts from teachers updating you on class learning via Class Dojo or other methods.
- 1 Open Afternoon or Assembly per year to share the class and individual learning.

I shall be seeking your opinion about these new arrangements throughout the year to gauge impact and parent satisfaction.
