Uniform

We encourage all pupils to wear school uniform. This helps to instil a sense of pride and team spirit within our school. In short, wearing school uniform encourages our pupils to **Aim High!**

Pupils at Inch School are expected to wear the following items to school:

- Royal blue fleeces embroidered with the school logo.
- Royal blue sweatshirt with a school logo
- White polo shirt
- Trousers/skirts in grey or black
- Jogging trousers are acceptable but these must be plain without sports logos etc.
- Plain dark shoes
- Plain Shorts and T shirts and gym shoes are required for PE- pupils are asked to have their PE kit in school at all times.
- An overall / old shirt is required for messy activities

Start and End of the Day Routine:

Start

Children should line up in their classes beside the P1 doors (Blue Fire Doors). To start with there will be labelled cones. Their teachers will greet them once both the warning bell and 9am bell have gone at the beginning of the day.

Children travelling on the school bus will be met by a PSA at 850am and will stay in the playground until the bell rings.

End

The children will be dismissed from the P1 doors to an accompanying adult.

Teachers will escort the children to their allocated buses.

For the safety of your children, it is important to let school know if there are any changes to pick-up arrangements.
