

<p>BINGO</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw a grid with 9 squares • Choose a topic e.g. numbers, pets, colours • Fill your boxes • Get someone to be the caller <p>You can play this all in French or draw/write in English and the caller has to say the French word or vice versa.</p>	<p>UNLUCKY 13</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gather players to join you (2 will do but 3 or more is better) • Take turns to call numbers by counting to 13. • You can say 1, 2 or 3 numbers at a time. • E.g. P1: un, deux P2: trois P1: quatre, cinq, six • The person who says 13 is out. • You can change the unlucky number to be higher if you wish or every number that ends in 5 etc. 	<p>BBC BITESIZE</p> <p>You can find a range of topics here. <p>X10 OR +10 FRENCH NUMBER GAME</p> <p>Target is to reach/get as close to 100 as possible without going over it. You will need a die, paper and pen.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Person A roll – say the number, choose to add 10 to the number or multiply by 10. Say the number. Write it down. • Person B roll – repeat what Person A did. • Person A roll – repeat step 1 again. • Add your scores as you go to keep a running total. Stop when you get close enough. • Look online for numbers to 100. • (you could change the rules to use a smaller number) 	<p>KIM'S GAME</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play with at least one other person. • Pick a topic e.g. food, colours, numbers, pets etc. • Collect and arrange a number of these items in the middle of the group. • Identify the French name of all the items first. Make sure everyone in the group knows. • Everyone (bar 'Person A') closes their eyes.
